**Speak Out to Save Your Pension!**

**Join CSU-AAUP members in rejecting the anti-collective bargaining bill being heard in the Labor Committee Public Hearing Feb. 21**

**Attacks on state workers are underway by certain politicians in the Connecticut legislature** who aim to silence the voices of all public employees and strip their rights to negotiate a better future.

A proposed [bill would roll-back the ability to collectively bargain over pensions or medical insurance](#), stealing all working families' access to affordable care or retirement security.

This is the **first public hearing** scheduled for one of more than 100 proposed bills introduced this session that attack the rights of working people. It is among the **most egregious**. If passed, it would bring us a step closer to Wisconsin, where politicians destroyed collective bargaining and made the state a worse place to live and work.
